OUR PLEDGE

- Fast until 3:00 pm

Tuesday

- Read your daily scriptures and devotion
- Pray at 12:00 noon for at least 5 minutes include in your prayer: unemployed will find jobs that meet the needs of their family, and pray for Pastor Patterson and Sis. Patterson, as well as all Pastors and their Wives
- Fast until 3:00 pm

Wednesday

- Read your daily scriptures and devotion.
- Pray at 12:00 noon for at least 5 minutes include in your prayer: salvation for all who are lost, and wisdom and guidance from God
- Fast until 3:00 pm
- Attend Wednesday Prayer 10:00 am – 12:00 noon and/or W.O.W. Service 7:00 pm/ Mid-Week Service at your home church

Thursday

- Read your daily scriptures and devotion
- Pray at 12:00 noon for at least 5 minutes include in your prayer: youth hear the word of God and accept Jesus as their savior and pray for family members or friends who are lost
- Fast until 3:00 pm

Friday

- Read your daily scriptures and devotion
- Pray at 12:00 noon for at least 5 minutes include in your prayer: national church and leaders, for clergy, missionaries, and evangelist
- Fast until 3:00 pm

Saturday

- Read your daily scriptures
- Pray at 12:00 noon for at least 5 minutes - include in your prayer: those suffering from injustice, comfort for those grieving, healing for the sick, and perseverance for persons participating in the 40 days of consecration

“40” DAYS OF CONSECRATION: 2019

Seed Time and Harvest

While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease (Gen. 8:22, KJV).

As long as the earth is in existence there will be a time planting seeds and harvesting the crops that the seeds produce. Harvest is always preceded by the planting of *seed*. Seeds must be sown into a substance (types of soil) that is conducive for the seed to germinate. One of the most important aspects of germination is the death of the outer shell, which serves as a type of protection for the inside or *life* of the *seed*. After being planted in the soil (earth), the *life* that is inside the *seed* must be released to be able to produce more life, (a greater *harvest*). The outer shell which holds the life of the seed must die out; be done away with. This is why Jesus said in John 12:24; Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

The death of Christ was like the sowing of a *seed* into the earth, which is liken unto the dying of a corn of wheat, and most assuredly it brought forth a much greater *harvest*. A wheat corn dies when it is changed in the ground, the outer shell cracks open, dies, and disintegrates, and the inner seedling becomes the root of a fruitful new plant. As this was the process for the Head, Christ, so will be the process for the members of His Body; the Church (Geneva Study Bible. John 12:24).

As long as the natural earth and that which was made from the earth remain, there will be *seed* time and *harvest*, as well as the seasons that are conducive to the sustenance of life.

The Righteous Seed – The Word

Jesus came as the Word/Seed wrapped in flesh (the outer man), that was formed out of the dust of the ground. He came as the God/man described in John chapter 1, verses 1 through 4. In the beginning was the one who is called the Word. The Word was with God and was truly God.² From the very beginning the Word was with God. And with this Word, God created all things. Nothing was made without the Word. Everything that was created received its life from him, and his life gave light to everyone. Verse 14 goes on to say; The Word became a human being and lived here with us. We saw his true glory, the glory of the only Son of the Father. From him all the kindness and all the truth of God have come down to us. (Contemporary English Bible CVE).

As the Word/Seed is most important to the production a great harvest, let us investigate further this Word/Seed that knows no boundaries!! Keeping in mind there can be no harvest without the planting of seeds.

These daily devotional writings are written to keep us constantly reminded of just how super-naturally unstoppable, all powerful, and without limits the Word/Seed of God really is. I know this statement in describing God's Word may sound a bit extreme, but His Word is all that and so much more.

From the beginning of the book of Genesis to the last chapter of the book of Revelation, we see the super-natural power of His awesome Word going forth accomplishing His every bidding bringing forth the expected harvest of the good seeds that were planted into good soil. When the Word/seed is watered with faith and patience, we will be amazed at how God's awesome Word will change the outcome, or change us, that we may come out victorious.

The Soil Which Houses the Word/Seed

Day 1: July 1st 2019

(A Hinder to the Harvest)

Matthew 13:18-19 (NKJV), Therefore hear the parable of the sower: When anyone hears the word of the kingdom, and does not understand it, then the wicked *one* comes and *snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is he who received seed by the wayside.

The soil which houses the seed must possess the necessary nutrients conducive for healthy crop production. If this is necessary to produce healthy crops in the natural, so it is with spiritual crops. That being said let us examine the parable of the sower as he expounds on the different types of soil the Word/seed fell on and in.

In the discourse of Matthew 13:1-9, Jesus speaks a profound parable, in verses 18-23; Jesus explains the meaning of the parable concerning the various state of the heart's soil, which also helps to understand the different outward expression and responses one may have in receiving Jesus the Word/the Seed, and allowing Him to break forth and grow properly in our hearts. Let us keep in mind, there is NOTHING wrong with the SEED of the WORD!

Matthew 13:3-4 (NKJV), Then He spoke many things to them in parables, saying: Behold, a sower went out to sow. And as he sowed, some *seed* fell by the **wayside**; and the birds came and devoured them.

The wayside heart is the heart that is out of place. We may have heard the expression, "their heart was in the wrong place," or out of proximity to where it should be. This type of heart is in condition of neglect or disuse, not taking into consideration the importance or the preciousness of the Word/Seed. Something else becomes priority, and because of that, the Seed became unimportant and fell by the "wayside." This is why the Seed of the Word could be easily snatched away by Satan even though it was sown in the heart. (It is like snatching something from some ones hand that is unimportant; therefore it is never retrieved).

Day 2: July 2nd 2019

Matthew 13:5-6 (NKJV), Some fell on stony places, where they did not have much earth; and they immediately sprang up because they had no depth of earth. But when the sun was up they were scorched, and because they had no root they withered away.

Matthew 13:20-21 (AMPC), As for what was sown on thin (rocky) soil, this is he who hears the Word and at once welcomes and accepts it with joy;

Yet it has no real root in him, but is temporary (inconstant, ^[a]lasts but a little while); and when affliction or trouble or persecution comes on account of the Word, at once he is caused to stumble [he is repelled and ^[b]begins to distrust and desert Him Whom he ought to trust and obey] and he falls away.

This type of heart soil received and welcomed the Word/Seed with much joy, but did not follow through with the necessary maintenance of clearing the heart, to allow the Word to get deep enough into the soil of the heart, to make the heart ready to receive and hold on the Word; such as prayer and meditation in the Word, faith teaching, the power of forgiveness and being forgiven, as well as church attendance and fellowship. These are the start-up tools made available by the Holy Spirit to dig within the rocky soil of our hearts to rid it of the stones and hard places of sin, disobedient, past and present hurts, unbelief, shame and embarrassment.

When these tools are not put in place and activated, the heart is not equipped to endure the fierce and destructive onslaughts from Satan and his cohorts; nor the pressuring tribulations, anguish, adversity, and offences that will come because of the Word.

One may run well, but only for a short time; as hindrances by some or all these things bring great discouragement. This happens because the stones, rocks, and pebbles usually due to ones stubbornness, were not *allowed* to be removed from the heart's soil. We must not only endure for a while, but until the end. Lord prepare, equip, and qualify our hearts to endure until the end!!

Day 3: July 3rd 2019

Matthew 13:7 (NKJV)

And some fell among thorns, and the thorns sprang up and choked them.

Matthew 13:22 (NKJV)

Now he who received seed among the thorns is he who hears the word, and the cares of this world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word, and he becomes unfruitful.

The cares of **this** world (like thorns and weeds), have the tendency to choke out the mind-set of of God's people being citizen of another Kingdom; the Kingdom of God! Worldly cares can become great hindrances to our receiving and maintaining the Word/Seed (Matthew Henry). The cares and thing of this world, those things not pertinent to our salvation, life and godliness, like thorns, find their way to God's furnace to be burned up. Heb. 6:8; Matt. 13:30, alludes to anything in this life that is apart from that which is cultivated by God (thorns, briars, tares), will be burned up. We must be **careful** not to be caught up in the same fire.

Matthew 13:22b, **The deceitfulness of riches**

It is not riches, but the deceitfulness of riches. When deceived by riches one can see themselves "better," "greater," and "intellectually" brighter than others; even God. If not careful having riches will change a person's character. They become deceived about who they really are. Deceit chokes out the true knowledge of God. Consequently, being deceived some chase after riches, convinced that they don't need God.

Proverbs 23:4-5 (NIV)

Do not wear yourself out to get rich; do not trust your own cleverness. Cast but a glance at riches, and they are gone, for they will surely sprout wings and fly off to the sky like an eagle.

Proverbs 30:8-9 (NIV)

Keep falsehood and lies far from me; give me neither poverty nor riches, but give me only my daily bread. Otherwise, I may have too much and disown you and say, 'Who is the Lord?' Or I may become poor and steal, and so dishonor the name of my God.

In reading these scripture passages we can clearly see that one cannot put confidence in riches, as they can be very deceitful and choke out the Word/Seed if we are not sold out to God.

Day 4: July 4th 2019

Matthew 13:8-9 Matthew 13:8-9 (NKJV)

But others fell on good ground and yielded a crop: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. He who has ears to hear, let him hear!”

Matthew 13:23 (HCSB)

But the one sown on the good ground—this is one who hears and understands the word, who does bear fruit and yields: some 100, some 60, some 30 times what was sown.”

Most often, the spiritual ground of our hearts does not start out being good ground. Good ground becomes what it is because of the on-going cultivation of the Holy Spirit. He knows where and when cultivation is needed. He goes into the shallow and deep places of the heart and begins the process of excavation, which is, unearthing, digging up, uncovering, and revealing what is hidden in the heart and needs to be dealt with. He does not spare for our crying. Isn't that wonderful!! It is joyous to know that God loves us this much! He is greatly concerned about the quality of our life's crop as well as the size of the yield.

The Life and Power that is in the Word/Seed

Day 5: July 5th 2019

Hebrews 4:12-13 (NIV)

For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

God's Word is bursting with life and is extremely active. Secondly, it is penetrates. The Word senses the condition of our hearts as well as the intention of our heart, which lays bare and exposed to the scrutiny of the eyes of the Lord which are in every place beholding the evil and the good (Prov. 15:3). One could safely say the Word performs an autopsy on our hearts. The Sword of the Spirit, the Word of God (Eph. 6:17), is energized by the Holy Spirit (pneuma, breath, spirit), which transfer the Logos (written) Word, to the Rhema (living, alive, and active) Word of God. This Sword is not used to slay or kill, but to **"judge"** the character of the heart.

The powerful Holy Spirit slices deeply and very sharp, but as gentle as possible to every minuet, microscopic detail of sin and disobedience; or any **"thing"** that may be out of place in our hearts. The Word pierces through the hardened places, penetrating and dividing as it goes, separating that which is soulish from that which is Spiritual. It undresses every idea and thought. It looks deeply into what the mind is thinking and planning to bring into fruition.

*Without the soil of our hearts being cleansed by Word, and being strongly dealt with by Word daily, we can only produce a sub-standard, faulty **harvest**; be it personal or other-wise. We can only produce what we have become and what we are. This is why we must embrace and digest the pure untainted Word/Seed of God.*

Let us now look at the Benefits of receiving the Pure Untainted Word/Seed of God

Day 6: July 6th 2019

Psalm 119:130 (KJV)

The Entrance of thy Word giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple.

My Word is the doorway that gives illumination and causes one to see and understand who I am, and how I feel about you, and even My plan for your life. In the light of My Word I make wise the simple. As you immerse yourself in My Word, you will receive insight, instruction, and understanding. As you walk in the light of My Word I will continually reveal Myself to you. For it is My delight to have ongoing sweet fellowship with you. My unfailing Word will serve as a compass, and guide you through every situation, every circumstance, every test and trial that you will encounter as you sojourn through this earth realm. The answer to your dilemma is in My Word, leading you safely to your eternal home where you will forever bask in the light of My Presence.

Day 7: July 7th 2019

Psalm 119:11 (KJV)

Thy Word have I hidden in my heart that I might not sin against thee.

Tuck My Word away in your heart. When that old serpent, the devil come knocking at the door of your heart and mind with propositions and temptations to sin, send My Word to answer the door. He will promptly dismiss himself every time with tail tucked between his legs. When he comes back, (for he will return), repeat the same process, let My Word answer the door. Sure victory is yours.

Day 8: July 8th 2019

Psalm 119:105 (KJV)

Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path.

Even as you walk in the darkness of the unknown; I will keep your feet in the path of My ordained destiny for your life as you study and walk in the light of My Word. For My Word is light and life.

Day 9: July 9th 2019

Psalm 119:89 (KJV)

Forever, O Lord, thy Word is settled in heaven.

It's a done deal!! What I have spoken, I have spoken! There is no variableness or changing in My character or nature. I have honored My Word above all My Name. My Word is the epitome of integrity. I have never been caught in a lie, nor ever will be!! I AM WHO I AM! I am Jehovah.

Day 10: July 10th 2019

Psalm 119:2 (KJV)

Blessed are they that keep His Testimonies, and that seek Him with the whole heart.

So very happy and full of joy are you who through faith in My integrity have kept and are keeping My Word. Through the faith process you are learning that I Am the God you can trust. Trust Me with your whole self. I won't leave nor forsake you; I Am God.

Day 11: July 11th 2019

Psalm 119:98 (KJV),

Thou through thy commandments hast made me wiser than mine enemies: for they are ever with me.

Walking in the instructions of My Word produces the God kind of wisdom. You will always have the advantage over the enemy. Keep your personal, professional, and spiritual life wrapped up in My Word; peace, success, and joy is yours. This is why the enemy (the devil, Satan) wants to infiltrate our hearts with junk, stuff and mess. If the soil of our hearts is messed up, it affect how the Word is received and lived out in our lives.

Day 12: July 12th 2019

Psalm 119:92 (KJV)

Unless thy law had been my delights, I should then have perished in mine affliction.

Let My law, My Word, My precepts, and promises be your delight; even in strong trials and testing, and when afflicted. You'll come out better, not bitter. You will learn and experience things about Me that you never would have known had you not gone through what you allowed Me to take you through. I **love you** and will **never** forsake you **My** child.

Day 13: July 13th 2019

Psalm 119:111 (KJV)

Thy testimonies have I taken as an heritage forever: for they are the rejoicing of my heart.

You can safely trust what I Jehovah have spoken, for **I Am El Elyon the Most High God**, I AM the first cause of **everything**, I own the heavens and the earth, **My Name is Truth, Justice, and Righteousness**. I AM Sovereign. In this fact you can greatly rejoice!!

This is what My law is and does: The law of the Lord perfect, converting the soul; the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple.

The statutes of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes.

The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever: the judgments of the Lord are true and righteous all together.

More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb.

Moreover by them is thy servant warned, and in keeping them is great reward.

(Psalm 19: 7-11) AWESOME ISN'T IT!!!

Day 14: July 14th 2019

Psalm 119:160 (KJV)

Thy Word is true from the beginning: and every one of thy righteous judgments endureth forever.

I, (My Word), do not get tired. I AM **Supernatural Endurance**. Your problems, situations, nor circumstances can wear Me out. Every *thing* must, and will bow and become subject to Me. I always finish what I start.

Day 15: July 15th 2019

Psalm 119:162 (KJV)

I rejoice at thy Word, as one that findeth great spoil.

Rejoice in the fact that My Word is always at work in you and for you. Trust Me, and allow Me to be the incomprehensible richness in your day to day life, I promise you, I satisfy.

Day 16: July 16th 2019

Psalm 119:165 (KJV)

Great peace have they which love thy law and nothing shall offend them.

Great peace comes with an intimate, deep love relationship with My Word. Offences lose their strength, and are replaced by a peaceful serenity that will overshadow you. They will roll off your inner man (soul); the oil of My Holy Spirit takes away their ability to adhere to your mental/emotional, and spiritual life.

Day 17: July 17th 2019

Psalm 119:172 (KJV)

My tongue shall speak of thy word: for all thy commandments *are* righteous.

Bragg on Me your Father; boast in Me I am the righteous one, the one who always keeps His promise, the one who never fails.

Day 18: July 18th 2019

Psalm 119:72 (AMCV)

The law from your mouth *is* better unto me than thousands of gold and silver pieces.

Gold and silver pale in comparison to what the wisdom of My Word can do in your life. My Word operating in and through your life produces wisdom, favor, riches and honor.

Day 19: July 19th 2019

Psalm 119:62 (KJV)

At midnight I will rise to give thanks unto thee because of thy righteous judgments.

Since I never sleep; even at midnight I await your praise and thanksgiving unto Me. My decisions concerning you have always been based on my perfect love for you, your destiny, and the plans I have for your life. Wake up sleepy head! I have some revelatory things I'd love to share with you.

Day 20: July 20th 2019

Psalm 119:9 (KJV)

Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed thereto according to thy word.

I will make your ways and your way clean. I will clean the debris from your life and clear the pathway I have chosen for you to travel. Only let My Word be your compass and road map.

Day 21: July 21st 2019

Psalm 119:15 (KJV)

I will meditate in thy precepts, and have respect unto thy ways.

Remember My laws and precepts. Speak them continually to your mind and heart. Even speak them into the atmosphere until they become the very essences of your existence.

Day 22: July 22nd 2019

Psalm 119:16 (KJV)

I will delight myself in thy statutes: I will not forget your word.

Let My Word and My precepts be thy delight, let them be indelibly written in your heart and mind.

Day 23: July 23rd 2019

Psalm 119:18 (KJV)

Open thou mine eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of thy law.

I will give you super-natural vision, sight beyond sight. I will reveal to you the hidden manna in My Word. You will have clear insight of the times and season in which you live.

Day 24: July 24th 2019

Psalm 119:19 (KJV)

I *am* a stranger in the earth; hide not thy commandments from me.

As you meditate in My Word and give it first place in your life, I will reveal sacred mysteries. Mysteries that I only reveal to those who choose to follow Me very closely; those who place their tiny feet in My gigantic footprints as I lead the way.

Day 25: July 25th 2019

Psalm 119:20 (KJV)

My soul breaketh for the longing that it hath unto thy judgments at all times.

It is good that your soul longs after Me to the point of breaking. That pleases Me greatly. It prompts Me to pour out to you the richness of My grace and blessing on your life. For I AM sooooo moved by your thirst and hunger for Me. I'll withhold no good thing from you.

Day 26: July 26th 2019

Psalm 119:24 (KJV)

Thy testimonies also *are* my delight *and* my counsellors.

Remember, there is safety in the multitude of counsel; the guiding counsel of My Word. Check out the words of My testimony. Your inner and outer person will leap for joy! It doesn't get any better than seeing My rightly divided Word in action, bringing forth the desired harvest.

Day 27: July 27th 2019

Psalm 1119:50 (KJV)

This is my comfort and consolation in my affliction: that you word has revived me and given me life.

Even when afflictions come because of disobedience; you turning back to Me and My Word in repentance cause My comforting consolation to be poured upon you. I will revive you and give you a fresh and new start.

Day 28: July 28th 2019

Psalm 119:46 (KJV)

I will speak of thy testimonies also before kings, and I will not be ashamed.

Be not ashamed of My Words. For I **rule** and **super rule**, and will deliver you and bring you out of afflictions and trouble in the presence of great men and those in authority.

Day 29: July 29th 2019

Psalm 119:67)KJV)

Before I was afflicted I went astray; but now have kept thy word.

My Word will chasten (correct) My children, those that I Love. My rod of love is sometimes painful but it will cause you to mature and grow up in spiritual and natural things. It will bring you into My desired destiny for your life.

Day 30: July 30th 2019

Psalm 119:71 (KJV)

It is good for me that I have been afflicted; that I might learn thy statutes.

Afflictions teach many good lessons, as they did for My servant king David. They provoked him to seek and search after the things that pleased My heart. In doing so, he learned many deep and intimate things about me others did not know. He found the secret place. O! The secret place in Me is a place of loving correction and refinement; it is also a place of rest, refreshment, and protection as I teach you valuable lessons of life. I await you My beloved.

Day 31: July 31st 2019

Psalm 105:19 (KJV)

Until the time that his word came: the word of the Lord tried him.

My Word must be tried and tested in **you** so you'll know where you stand in **Me**, and be assured of who I really am; knowing that I AM not a man that I should lie. Just ask Joseph. The prophetic word he shared with his father and his cruel brothers tried him and tested him. The same word that tried him is the same word that cleared and blessed him. His deep heart rending mental/emotional and physical pain, had to bow to future prophetic preferment that God Himself had laid on his life. It ushered him into his destiny.

Day 32: August 1st 2019

Psalm 147:15 (KJV)

He sendeth forth his commandments *upon* the earth: his word *runneth swiftly*.

My Word was already waiting for Joseph when he arrived in Egypt. So it is with you. When you arrive to the place of testings, trials, and afflictions, you'll run **smack dab** into My Word. As My Word came to fruition in Joseph's life, so shall it be in yours.

Day 33: August 2nd 2019

Psalm 18:30 (KJV)

As *for* God, His way *is* perfect: the word of the Lord is tried: he is a buckler to all those that trust in him.

My Word has already passed life's test. The whole universe rest in My perfection. The sun does not come up at night, nor the moon give it's illumination during the day. My universe continues to operate like a well oiled machine. Cast you cares on Me. Trust Me and have confidence in My integrity; I AM your sustainer.

Day 34: August 3rd 2019

Psalm 107:20 (KJV)

He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions

I send My Word to heal every malady that could and would touch any area or any *thing* that humanity comes in contact with. My Word covers everything; it leaves nothing out. I AM *the* I AM.

Day 35 : August 4th 2019

Proverb 5: 30)KJV)

Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him.

My Word is without guile or deception. There is no variableness or changing in who I AM. My Word is who I Am.

Day 36: August 5th 2019

Isaiah 40: 8 (KJV)

The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the Word of our God standeth forever.

Everything the eye can see in the natural is temporal: it will wither as the grass, and fade as the most beautiful flower does. For everything in the natural is in a constant state of dying; weak and withering away. But My Word stands forever strong and undiminished in Power and Might.

Day 37: August 6th 2019

Isaiah 55: 11 (KJV)

So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall *accomplish* that which I please, and it shall prosper *in the thing* whereto I sent it.

My Word will not return unto Me without producing *My desired effect in and on the thing or things I sent it to*. It shall bring them to fruition, to completion of what I please.

(It's doing it in your life right now!!)

Day 38: August 7th 2019

Jeremiah 23: 29 (KJV)

Is not my word like fire? Saith the Lord; and like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?

The heat of My word hardens what I desire to harden, and melts down that which I desire to soften. My Word the hammer breaks up any resistance that comes up against it.

Day 39: August 8th 2019

Matthew 4: 4 (KJV)

But he answered and said, It is written, Man should not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

My child, always be cognizant of Satan's set-ups as he tries twist My Word. Put your soul under double guard of My Holy Spirit. *Submit* therefore *yourself unto Me*, then and only then will you have *resisting power and authority*.
